Experience the ultimate in leadership training! 21st Century Wood Badge is advanced leadership training that will provide you with the leadership skills to make a difference. Wood Badge was started by Lord Baden Powell in 1919, and more than 100,000 Scouters have proudly worn the Wood Badge beads.

21st Century Wood Badge brings together leaders from all areas of Scouting—Cub Scouting, Boy Scouting, Varsity Scouting and Venturing—for training, adventure and Fun!!! Wood Badge draws from the best leadership models in America and applies them to training our youth to strength our units, deliver the promise of Scouting, and train the leaders of tomorrow. You will live the magic of Scout leadership training as envisioned by the founder of Scouting—Lord Baden Powell. This training course would cost over \$3,000 if it was taken in private industry.

Wood Badge consists of two parts. The first part is a two-weekend experience, living with a group of Scouters in an outdoor environment. During this time, participants are trained in leadership skills in order to better serve their units. Through this living/working experience, each person develops knowledge and understanding of these skills. This team-development model is in widespread use in corporate leadership training and will be an invaluable tool in all aspects of your Scouting, business, and personal life. During the second part—after the outdoor experience—participants work on commitments made during the two weekends. A maximum of 18 months may be used to finish these goals in order to fully complete the course. Each person will be evaluated on their performance. Upon successful completion of Wood Badge, Scouters receive their beads of recognition.

Who May Attend

This training is for all Boy Scouts of America adult leaders: Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Varsity, Venturing, District and Council leaders.

How To Qualify To Attend

You can participate in this exciting two-weekend training course if you:

1. Are currently registered as an adult Scouter In a Cub Scout, Boy Scout or Venturing unit, or in a district or council level position.
2. Whether you have attended Wood Badge in the past or not.
3. Are at least 21 years of age (Assistant Scoutmasters must be at least 18).
4. Have completed Youth Protection training and training specific to your Scouting position.
5. Submit a completed application and pay the entire fee prior to April 21, 2010.

Cost of Course

The total cost of the course is \$200.00. A deposit of \$75.00 is due when the application is submitted, the deposit is non-refundable after April 1, 2010. The balance of the fee must be paid by April 21, 2010. If registering after April 15, 2010, the total fee of \$225.00 is due. The fee covers training materials, food and equipment for the entire course. You provide your personal gear, tent and uniform. Class A, complete uniform is needed for each person. A detailed list will be sent to you, once application and payment has been received. Payment schedule: \$75 with application; \$125 must be paid by April 21, 2010; \$225 in full is due when paying after April 15, 2010.

Location Of Course

The course will be held at Camp Chief Logan near Chapmanville, West Virginia. Take the “Garretts Fork” exit off US 119. The camp is 1 mile on right.

Dates Of Course

Wood Badge is a two-weekend (Friday through Sunday) course scheduled as follows:

First weekend: Friday, May 21 through Sunday May 23, 2010

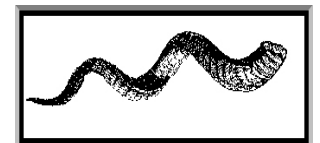
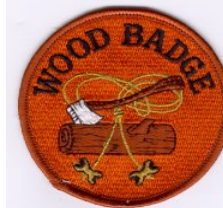
Second weekend: Friday, June 4, through Sunday, June 6, 2010
